MAKE ETHICAL DECISIONS TRAINING

Effective in the 2014-2015 curling season, the Make Ethical Decisions (MED) Multi-sport Training Module will be delivered in a curling environment as part of the Competition Coach Training weekend!

Who should take the training?

- Coaches taking the Competition Coach training that weekend
- Coaches who have taken the Competition Coach Training in the past, but still need to take their MED training
- Level's based coaches who would like to upgrade their training

When is the MED Training being offered?

- Generally will be offered on the Friday night prior to a Competition Coach Workshop to allow participants to take only that section of the workshop if they need to—but check your Member Association's website for details or other opportunities
- Since this is new this season, MED workshops are being phased into the course calendar—check your Member Association's website to see when they are being offered

Why do I need MED Training?

 MED Training helps prepare coaches for the tough decisions they'll be faced with throughout their coaching careers. It also helps prepare coaches for the mandatory MED Evaluation that is part of certification requirements for Competition Coach and Competition Development
