Notes: Design a Basic Sport Program - is offered as a MSM in Intro to Competition B, Plan a Practice 1 - is offered as a MSM in Intro to Competition A or Competition Coach (Curling). (\*) Each of these modules are offered by P/TSO.

Program will take approximately 14 months to complete, as it requires writing, implementing, executing and debriefing an annual plan. In addition to the annual plan portfolio, two observation evaluations (a practice and a competitive environment) must be completed. Coaches will need to complete the Competition Development Make Ethical Decision Online Evaluation, and will need to complete the **four** remaining Competition development multisport modules – Managing Conflict, Coaching and Leading Effectively, Psychology of Performance, Leading Drug Free Sport.
